I have some good friends and we are in the same class. Kitty is the fattest girl. She is our class monitor. We all like her because she is kind and helpful.

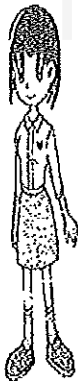
Betty is thin and she is the tallest in the class. She is clever and always comes first in the tests.
